Since version 3.0.0, pacman has been the front-end to libalpm (3), the "Arch Linux Package Management" library. This library allows alternative front-ends to be written (for instance, a GUI front-end). Invoking pacman involves specifying an operation with any potential options and targets to operate on.

Artix Linux is very close to Arch Linux, more than Manjaro, but still offers the comfort of the Calamares graphical installer and doesn't use systemd.
