The front of the boat should always be pointed into the wind when rigging, as the sail when hoisted, catches the wind and causes the whole structure to fall on its side. Prior to mast stepping, check that you are well clear of any overhead power lines and ensure that the sailing dinghy can be wheeled to the water without the mast coming in contact with power lines or tree branches.

1. From the delivery kit locate the sail, upper and lower booms, S hook and package of sail rings. Remove the two outhaul lines from the line bag. 2. Most sailboats have one mainsail and one headsail. Typically, the mainsail is a fore-and-aft bermuda rig (triangular shaped). A jib or genoa is used for the headsail. Most sailors use additional sails for different conditions: the spinnaker (a common downwind sail), gennaker, code zero (for upwind use), and stormails. Each sail has its own use.

Fortunately, rig tuning is a straightforward step by step process for both masthead and fractional rigs. The goals in rig tuning are the following: (1) Eliminate side bend and lean, (2) Set mast rake for proper helm balance, (3) Set pre-bend to match the mainsail design, and (4) Control mast bend and headstay sag.

As always we recommend seeking the advice of a professional rigger for more specific tips and tricks regarding tuning your boat's rigging. Your boat must be in the water. Begin by just slacking off all of the side shrouds as evenly as possible, so that all stays can be adjusted by hand.

Attach three eyetelets to the deck and select those based on the rig in use. A small aluminum channel gives all trim option later. A small hook connects to the fishing tackle swivel which, in turn, can be hooked to the jib boom using a triangular hook like on the main boom.

A popular rig for midsize cruising boats is the ketch, which is like a sloop with a second, smaller mast set aft called the mizzenmast. The mizzen sail functions much like a second mainsail. Stays are the taut lines of the standing rigging that stabilise the mast backward and forward, running from the front of the vessel--fore--to the rear of the vessel--aft. On the foremast of a multi-masted vessel, the forestay will run from the bowsprit (the beam protruding from the bow) to the top of the foremast.
